



Maritime Graduate Scholarships

With generous support from our partner, the Port of Houston Authority, the Department of Transportation of Studies offers scholarships (1k/year) to qualified students pursuing the Master of Science degree in Transportation Planning and Management, and concentrating on the Maritime Transportation Management and Security area. Scholarship awards may include payment assistance for tuition, fees, and/or books per semester.



🖔 Criteria:

- Must have at the time of application a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 GPA scale
- Must apply for admission and be admitted to TSU before awarded the scholarship
- Must select TSU Transportation Planning and Management as major and concentrate on Maritime Management and Security area.
- Maintain GPA requirements each semester during the duration of the scholarship
- Must submit completed application form by the deadline
- Must submit two (2) typed letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher/professor, counselor, or principal on school letterhead)
- Must submit college transcript
- Must be U.S citizens or permanent residents in the United States at the time of application and after graduation
- Must submit a one (1) page typed essay (500 -1000 words) addressing the following: "How Will the Maritime Transportation Scholarship Impact Your Education and Prepare You for a Career in the Maritime Industry?"

- Review of Scholarship Applications: April 16-30, 2018
- Interviews Conducted (if necessary): May 1-5, 2018
- Award notifications sent to students: May 15, 2018
- Students Confirm Acceptance of Scholarship: May 30, 2018
