Candidates must be detail oriented there will be a great deal of responsibility to review, analyze and modify programming systems including encoding, testing, debugging and installing to support various business applications and databases.

We expect any candidate to not only be knowledgeable of best practices but to champion, implement and continuously improve RGRTA's operational and customer technology practices and protocols to ensure adherence to any regulatory compliance requirements, employ change management control, supervise development lifecycle practices, develop policies and safeguard the security and integrity of assigned systems.

Candidates must be able to:

1. Design, encode, test, debug, construct and maintain web applications in C# and VB.Net.
2. Provide expert advice and guidance on Internet technologies, mobile apps and techniques that may be deployed to support organizational initiatives.
3. Work with end users, departments, customers and third party vendors to establish needs, gather requirements, create specifications and develop new programs, as well as design and write code to support existing applications.
