



## TEXAS SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY MEDICAL HEALTH PHYSICS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To be eligible for the Medical Health Physics Scholarship Program at Texas Southern University (TSU), the applicant should hold a minimum of junior level status as of fall 2014. Candidates must be actively pursuing a degree in the Health Physics (HP). Applicants must have an interest in applied radiation physics disciplines such as health physics and/or medical physics. Scholarship recipients will receive \$7,000 per year towards tuition and fees plus an annual stipend up to \$3500 over a two-year period. 1. *United States Citizenship, Lawful Permanent Resident, or Naturalized Citizen*
2. *Junior Status as of fall 2014*
3. *Grade Point Average – 3.3 or higher on a 4.0 scale*
4. *Interested in careers in applied radiation physics*

  - *Motivation and demeanor*
  - *Communication skills*
  - *Time management capabilities*
  - *Professionalism*
