**Study Level:** Undergraduate, Graduate

**Award Type:** Award, Internship

**Purpose:** To provide undergraduate and beginning graduate students the opportunity to learn more about the Smithsonian and their academic fields through direct experience in research or museum-related internship projects under the supervision of research and professional staff members at the Institution's many museums, research institutes and offices.

**Focus:** Animal science and behavior; Anthropology; Earth sciences; Arts; Social sciences; Culture.

**Qualifications:** Applicants must be currently engaged in undergraduate or graduate study, and an overall GPA of 3.0 or its equivalent generally is expected.

**Criteria:** Selection will be based on the committee's criteria.

**Funds:** \$550.

**Duration:** 10 weeks.

**To Apply:** Applicants must visit the website for the online application process. Once registered, applicants must prepare a two-to-four page essay for internships or a not more than 1,500 words, maximum six pages typescript, double spaced research proposal for visiting students; transcripts; resume; and references.

**Deadline:** February 1 and October 1.
