Qualifications: The successful applicants must: have basic HTML skills including editing and troubleshooting. Experience with Dreamweaver or another HTML editor is preferred. CSS knowledge is a plus; have basic photo/image editing experience; have experience working with Content Management Systems. Drupal experience is a plus; have great written and verbal communications skills; be very organized, have a strong attention to detail, and be able to complete projects independently; be very tech savvy and have the ability to learn new technology quickly; be genuinely concerned and conversant about LGBT issues and have a passion and desire to make a difference. All GLAAD interns are required to be students attending an institution with courses leading to a degree, certificate or diploma, such as college or graduate school. Interns must have graduated from high school.

Criteria: Selection will be based on the committee's criteria.

Funds: No specific amount.

To Apply: Applicants must submit a brief cover letter outlining their interest and experience specific to the position and their current resume. The title of the position must appear in the first line of the email. Applicants must answer one of the following questions in their cover letter: Describe a social media campaign you thought was particularly successful. What worked and why? What could have made it more effective? Describe a social media campaign you found to be particularly unsuccessful. What failed and why? What could have made it more effective?
