Purpose: To support students wishing to pursue a graduate study in transportation engineering.

Focus: Transportation.

Qualifications: Applicant must be planning to pursue a Master's degree in transportation engineering with a principal course work in traffic engineering, geometric design and/or transportation planning; have earned, or will earn a bachelor's degree and must be qualified for unconditional admission to the graduate study program at the chosen host university; must not be a previous recipient of the fellowship; and must be from Texas and pursuing study at one of the universities within the district.

Criteria: Selection is based on applicant's past academic performance, the proposed program of study, an essay discussing the reasons for pursuing a graduate degree in transportation and outlining career objectives, as well as recommendations from three references.

Funds: \$1,000.

Duration: One academic year.

Number of Awards: Up to 2.

To Apply: Applicants must submit an application along with the essay; a copy of resume; and a list of proposed courses taken in working toward the degree for each university/college listed. In addition, applicants must submit, under separate cover, a completed reference form from each of the reference named in the application and an official transcript from each college/university attended prior or is currently attending.

Deadline: April 1.
