Qualifications: Applicants must be of Hispanic American, African American, Asian Pacific Islander American or American Indian/Alaskan Native heritage; U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents with a valid Social Security Number and a permanent resident card or passport stamped I-551; have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale; a sophomore majoring in chemical engineering, civil engineering, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering, petroleum engineering, geology, geophysics, accounting, marketing, global procurement or supply chain management, environmental health & safety, energy management or petroleum land management, transportation & logistics or geotechnical engineering; or a senior pursuing a Masters degree in geology or geophysics; must participate in a possible paid summer internship opportunity in Marathon Oil Corporation; must apply for federal financing aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Criteria: Preference will be given to the applicants who best meet the requirements.

Funds: \$30,000.

Duration: Two academic years.

To Apply: Applications must be submitted using the HSF online application system.

Deadline: October 26.

Remarks: Scholars will be paired with a Marathon Oil Corporation employee as a professional mentor.
