Purpose: To assist students pursuing graduate or undergraduate studies leading to a career in student activities or a related student services field; to provide economic assistance to qualified underrepresented programmers; to increase the participation of ethnic minority individuals in the field of campus activities.

Focus: General studies.

Qualifications: Applicants must be matriculated undergraduates in good standing at the time of their application and during the semester in which the award is received; must be a member of the African-American, Latina/Latino, Native American, Asian American, or Pacific Islander ethnic minorities; hold a significant leadership position on campus or in the community; have made significant contributions via volunteer involvement, either on or off the campus.

Criteria: Recipients are selected based on the demonstrated leadership, academic record, and financial need.

Funds: No specific amount.

To Apply: Applicants must submit at least two letters of recommendation; resume or description of the applicant's leadership activities, skills, and ability, training, and accomplishment; official transcript of the applicant's current enrollment status from the college or university. Applicants must submit a 350-600-word statement describing their leadership program and how their participation met their professional development objectives.

Deadline: May 1.
